NO FURTHER APPLICATIONS WILL BE SUBMITTED UNTIL CONDITIONS ARE SUCH THAT THE PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS IS AGAIN DEEMED ADVISABLE. APPLICATIONS APPROVED BY THEATRE OCS BOARD WILL BE RETAINED TO FILL FUTURE QUOTAS UNQUOTE.
4. OFFICERS' POST EXCHANGE: Traveling Officers' Post Exchange will be at Bassingbourne on 26 and 27 June 1944.
