"NUMEROUS REPORTS OF DELINQUENCY HAVE BEEN RECEIVED BY THIS HEADQUARTERS FROM MILITARY POLICE OF LONDON ON OFFICERS UNDER THIS COMMAND FOR FAILING TO WEAR INSIGNIA OF RANK ON OUTER GARMENTS PARTICULARLY RAINCOATS. THIS WILL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF ALL PERSONNEL CONCERNED AND CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN."

4. MARKING OF SHIPPING CRATES: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division, dated 11 Sept 1944:
"1BD S-400-F. RULERS, COLOR STRIPES, COLOR BANDS OR INSIGNIA REPRESENTING UNIT SERIAL NUMBERS, SHIPPING NUMBERS, OR AEL OR BRANCH OF SERVICE WILL NOT REPEAT NOT BE PLACED ON SHIPPING CRATES, BOXES OR OTHER CONTAINERS BEING PREPARED FOR POSSIBLE DEPLOYMENT BY 1BD UNITS UNTIL INSTRUCTIONS ARE RECEIVED FROM THIS HEADQUARTERS."
