
"FOLLOWING TWX MSG RECEIVED FR 8AF QUOTE: D69831 FOR YOUR INFOR AND GUIDANCE EXISTING PROHIBITION AGAINST TRAVEL OF PERSONNEL WHILE OTHER THAN IN DUTY STATUS IN EXCESS OF 25 MILES IS INAPPLICABLE TO PERSONNEL GRANTED LEAVE PASS OR FURLOUGH PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF LETTER 8AF ONE APRIL SUBJECT QUOTE STOPPAGE OF LEAVE UNQUOTE.

SUCH TRAVEL RESTRICTION IS APPLICABLE ONLY TO PERSONNEL GRANTED PASS OR INFORMAL LEAVE PURSUANT TO LETTER ETO 25 MAY AG 210.71 X 220.71 MPGA SUBJECT QUOTE PASS AND INFORMAL LEAVES OF 24 HOUR DURATION UNQUOTE. COMBAT CREW MEMBERS ON LEAVE OR FURLOUGH PURSUANT TO THIS AUTHORITY WILL HAVE IN THEIR POSSESSION EVIDENCE INDICATING THEIR COMBAT CREW STATUS AS WELL AS DURATION OF LEAVE OR FURLOUGH.
