OF DUTY IN ACTUAL COMBAT DURING THE PERIOD IN WHICH HE HAS HELD HIS PRESENT
GRADE. THE OFFICER CONCERNED IS PRESENTLY OCCUPYING A COMBAT POSITION VACANCY
HAVING COMPLETED (NUMBER OF) MISSIONS. THE DATE OF HIS LAST MISSION IS (DATE).
THE CIRCUMSTANCES INVOLVED IN THIS CASE IN FACT EXCEPTIONAL."
WHEN REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF TIME IN GRADE OR POSITION IS REQUIRED, ABOVE
