TO EACH OFFICER AND ENLISTED MAN, TO OFFICER AND ENLISTED WACS, TO RAF AND RN PERSONNEL OF THE EIGHTH AIR FORCE, I EXTEND MY MOST SINCERE THANKS FOR THE SUPERB JOB YOU HAVE ALL DONE DURING THE CAMPAIGN THAT IS PAST. THE EIGHTH IS A TRULY GREAT AIR FORCE AND I AM PROUD OF EACH OF YOU WHO CONSTITUTE IT. I HAVE EVERY CONFIDENCE THAT THE LOYALTY AND DETERMINATION YOU HAVE EXHIBITED WILL CONTINUE THROUGHOUT THE CAMPAIGN THAT IS BEGINNING UNTIL IT, TOO, IS BROUGHT TO A CONCLUSION THROUGH DEFEAT OF THE GERMAN ENEMY.
