2. LIBERTY BELL FOR ENLISTED MEN: 326th Bomb Sq (H) will furnish one officer.
3. INCORRECT ADDRESSES: Headquarters, 119th Army Postal Unit, APO 634 has brought to the attention of this headquarters the fact that newspapers and magazines addressed to personnel of this command are being received there every day because they are erroneously addressed to APO 634. Such mail is being delayed needlessly, and the volume runs into thousands of pieces weekly thereby placing a tremendous burden on the personnel of the APO who have to scheme each piece in order to determine the correct APO number.
Attention is invited to the following excerpt from par 5, WD Memorandum No. WB40-31-43, 12 May 1943:
"Commanding Officers will require officers and enlisted personnel receiving publications....to notify publishers direct of their correct address."
It is requested that all officers and enlisted men of this command receiving periodicals addressed to APO 634 notify the publisher immediately of their complete military address showing unit designation and correct APO.
4. FURLOUGH LOANS: The Field Director, American Red Cross, is no longer permitted to make Regular Furlough Loans. This practice ceased the day before D Day and present policies do not permit its resumption.
5. ATTENTION ALL PERSONNEL: Headquarters, Eighth Air Force intends maintaining a "WHO'S WHO" of all personnel, both officers and enlisted men, of the Eighth Air Force, listing therein those individuals who are, or were:
 - A. Outstanding in aerial combat.
 - B. Outstanding in performance of important Eighth Air Force duties.
 - C. Outstanding in their business or profession in civilian life.If you come within one of these categories see Lt Finley, Public Relations Officer, in the S-2 Situation Room behind Group Headquarters, at once.
