3. COMMENDATION: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division dated 22 June 1944:
"FOL MSG RECD 8AF D-65216 QUOTE DATED 20 JUNE, THE FOLLOWING MSG FROM GEN SPAATZ HAS BEEN RECEIVED AT THIS HQ: QUOTE PRELIMINARY REPORTS OF THE BOMBING OF OIL AND OTHER TARGETS IN GERMANY TODAY ARE MOST ENCOURAGING. FROM ALL INDICATIONS, THIS WILL PROBABLY BE ANOTHER OF THE FINE EXAMPLES OF COORDINATED PRECISION BOMBING ATTACKS THAT HAS GIVEN THE EIGHTH AIR FORCE ITS ENVIABLE REPUTATION. THE SIMULTANEOUS DESTRUCTION OF THIS SERIES OF PLANTS SUPPORTING THE OIL INDUSTRY WILL HAVE A SERIOUS EFFECT ON GERMANY'S WAR EFFORT AND ATTACK ON THE TANK DEPOT AND MOTOR TRANSPORT AND AIRCRAFT COMPONENT FACTORY ALSO DEPRIVES THE ENEMY OF MORE OF HIS MOST CRITICAL WEAPONS. PLEASE EXTEND MY SINCERE CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL PARTICIPATING PERSONNEL FOR THE EXCEPTIONALLY FINE EXECUTION OF AN IMPORTANT OPERATION. SGD SPAATZ UNQUOTE. IT IS GRATIFYING TO FORWARD SUCH MSG. TO IT, ADD MY OWN COMMENDATION FOR THE EXCELLENT MANNER IN WHICH THIS ATTACK WAS ACCOMPLISHED. DOOLITTLE UNQUOTE.
