2. LIBERTY RUN FOR ENLISTED MEN: 32nd Sta Compl Sq will furnish one officer
3. CHANGE IN STARTING TIME OF LIBERTY RUN: Effective Tuesday, 25 July 1944, the Liberty Run will not leave the Base until 1845 hours in lieu of 1830 hours.
4. COMMENDATION: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division dated 22 July 1944:
"TWX/D-66695/8AF DTD 21 JULY 44 QUOTED FOR YOUR INFORMATION QUOTE IT GIVES ME GREAT PLEASURE TO FORWARD THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE FROM LORD TRENCHARD RECEIVED THIS HQ FROM AIR C-IN-C AFAF AND CG USSTAF: "MY VERY BEST CONGRATULATIONS ON THE GREAT AIR WORK IN THE BATTLE. IT HAS SAVED THOUSANDS OF ARMY CASUALTIES. IT IS SPLENDID. I CONGRATULATE YOU. ALL GOOD WISHES TO ALL YOUR COMMANDS." DOOLITTLE UNQUOTE. MY PERSONAL CONGRATULATIONS AND BEST WISHES TO YOU AND THE PERSONNEL OF YOUR COMMAND.

5. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS AND UNIT CENSORS: In accordance with instructions received from Hq, ETOUSA and 1st Bomb Division, all Unit Commanders will take immediate and positive action to insure that personnel of their organizations understand that no casualty information of any kind will be included in personal correspondence. Disclosures of casualties prior to official casualty reports cause distress to the families involved and place the War Department in an embarrassing position.
