2. LIMITATION FOR ENLISTED MEN: 327th Bomb Sq (H) will furnish one officer.

3. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: Commanding Officers will insure that all personnel of their respective units have their gas masks tested in the Gas Chamber at the Base Chemical Office before 1 October 1944.
The gas chamber will be available from 0900 hrs to 1700 hrs each day starting 25 Sep 44. All organizations will coordinate the time and date of the exercise with the Base Chemical office, Ext 23-RL, before proceeding to the gas chamber.

4. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: All organizations will submit a report to Station S-1 stating the number and amount of Class "B" (War Bond) allotments for the month of September, of officers in their command, not later than 0900 hours 26 Sept 44.

5. ADDRESSING AND CENSORING OF V-MAIL - On all red bordered V-mail the sender's name and the word "Free" must be written in longhand on the outside. Enlisted men's mail will be censored and the censor's signature appear only in the circle; officers mail must be signed BOTH in the circle and in the lower left hand corner on the outside.
