"ATTACK OF 18 JULY ON PEENEMUNDE WAS ONE OF THE FINEST EXAMPLES OF PRECISION BOMBING I HAVE SEEN. THE CONCENTRATED BOMBING ON EIGHT (8) SEPARATE, SMALL AIMING POINTS WITHIN THE TARGET AREA WAS MADE POSSIBLE BY THE FINE ORGANIZATION AND TRAINING OF EIGHTH AIR FORCE UNITS AND THE DETERMINATION OF COMMANDERS AND COMBAT CREWS ALIKE. THIS DEMONSTRATION REFLECTS GREAT CREDIT ON THE EIGHTH AIR FORCE AND THE UNITED STATES ARMY AIR FORCES. SIGNED SPAATZ.

IT IS VERY GRATIFYING FOR ME TO TRANSMIT TO YOU AND YOUR COMMAND THIS COMMENDATION FROM GENERAL SPAATZ FOR A JOB WELL DONE, AND I WISH TO ADD MY PERSONAL APPRECIATION AND CONGRATULATIONS THERETO. SIGNED DOOLITTLE UNQUOTE

ON THIS VITAL OPERATION THE 1ST DIVISION AGAIN DEMONSTRATED ITS ABILITY TO DESTROY THE ASSIGNED OBJECTIVE REGARDLESS OF ITS LOCATION OR ENEMY OPPOSITION.
