LEAVES - PASSES - FURLoughs: Following teletype received from Hq VIII AF: "ALL DIRECTIVES PERTAINING TO LEAVES PASSES AND FURLoughs ISSUED BETWEEN 31 MAR - 16 AUG BY THIS HQ LIMITING PROVISIONS CIR 34 EUROPEAN T OF OPNS ARE RESCINDED. GRANTING OF LEAVES PASSES AND FURLoughs HERAFTER GOVERNED BY CITED CIR AND LIR EUROPEAN T OF OPNS 17 AUG AG 210.711 X 220.711 MPGA SUB LEAVES FURLoughs AND PASSES".
4. RESERVATIONS FOR A.R.C. IN U.K: All ARC in the UK are being over-taxed for accommodations and in order to have an even chance for your reservation for a bed, Special Service requires that furlough papers be submitted TWO WEEKS in advance of departure from this station. All furlough papers must be approved by Commanding Officer before reservations can be made.
Personnel not wishing to use the facilities of an ARC, may make their own reservations direct and it is not necessary for the furlough paper to pass through Special Service. Wires can be sent from the Post Office at a nominal fee.
5. ATTENTION ALL PERSONNEL: Effective immediately, Lt Col ANDRE R. BROUSSEAU will sign all correspondence as Commanding Officer of the Group.
6. PARTIAL PAYMENTS - OFFICERS: Partial payments will be made to officers on this station in accordance with Army Regulations, which provide for same upon change of station under orders, upon being granted leave, and in emergency cases which are endorsed by the commanding officer. Payment will not be made by the Finance Office unless copies of the orders stating the change of station, or leave status are shown upon request.
