The Officer of the Day will report to the Base Adjutant at 1100 hrs. Immediately after reporting to the Adjutant and assuming his duties, the new Officer of the Day will report to the Provost Marshal.

4. ATTENTION ALL ENGINEERING SECTIONS: Due to a critical shortage of 7:50-20 tires it will be necessary to remove same from some 2 wheel Cargo Trailers and 250 gal Water Trailers. These will be installed on 2½ ton Cargo Trucks and the worn tires taken from the Cargo Trucks installed on the trailers.
5. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: Commanding Officers will insure that all personnel of their respective units have their gas masks tested in the gas chamber at the Base Chemical Office before 5 July 1944.  
The gas chamber will be available from 0900 hrs to 1700 hrs each day, starting 28 June 1944. It is suggested that organizations coordinate the time and date of the exercise with the Base Chemical Office Ext 23-R2, before proceeding to the gas chamber.
6. PX CLOSED SATURDAY 1 JULY 1944: The PX will be closed Saturday 1 July 1944, for inventory.
7.
