2. LIBERTY FUN FOR ENLISTED MEN: 327th Bomb Sq (H) will furnish one officer.
3. ATTENTION ALL UNIT VOTING OFFICERS: R E P E A T All Unit Voting Officers will arrange the necessary facilities pertaining to voting by personnel in the November general election. October 3rd, 6th, 9th, and 12th, will be designated voting days on this station for purpose of execution of the Federal ballots which will be furnished this headquarters in the near future. Only those personnel whose voting residence is that of one of the twenty (20) states authorizing the Federal ballot, will be permitted to vote this ballot.
Attention is directed to Ltr, Hq, European Theatre of Opns, file 47 014.35 PUBGA, Subj: "Supplementary Information pertaining to Voting by Servicemen and Certain Civilians in the November General Election", dated 9 August 1944.
4. POST EXCHANGE CLOSED: The Post Exchange will be CLOSED Saturday, 30 September 1944, for the purpose of taking inventory.
5. ATTENTION SQUADRON AGRICULTURAL OFFICERS: The following information rescinds any previous instructions pertaining to Squadron Agricultural Reports. Each organization will submit its Monthly Squadron Agricultural Report, on the forms provided, to Lt. J.S. Stinson, Base Agricultural Officer, on or before Saturday, 30 September 1944.
6. DAMAGED VOTING MATERIAL: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division, dated 28 September 1944:
"LDD S-1113-G FOL TR RECEIVED FROM HQ ETOUSA 23 SEP 44 FORWARDED FOR YOUR INFO AND GUIDANCE: 'EX-49356 REPORTS RECEIVED OF BALLOT ENVELOPE FLAPS BECOMING STUCK TO ENVELOPES REQUIRING FORCIBLE SEPARATION FOR USE IN VOTING REFERENCE NUMBER 45708 THIS HEADQUARTERS SIGNED LORD THE AUTHORIZED PROCEDURE FOR UTILIZING STUCK TOGETHER MATERIAL WILL BE USED BY ARMY PERSONNEL ONLY IF ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY AND NOT OTHERWISE. EFFORTS WOULD BE MADE TO SUBSTITUTE UNSPOOK MATERIAL. ACCORDINGLY YOU SHOULD MAKE CLEAR TO ALL SOLDIER VOTING PERSONNEL THAT THE AUTHORIZED PROCEDURE IS TO BE USED ONLY IN EXTREME EMERGENCY WHEN NO OTHER COURSE IS POSSIBLE TO ENABLE VOTING TO PROCEED."

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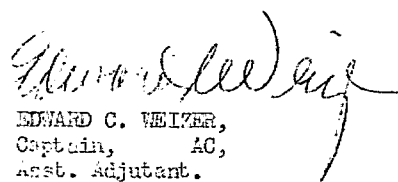
