EIGHTH AIR FORCE VICTORY SQUADRON WAR BOND CAMPAIGN: How do we stand???

Our assigned goal in the Victory Squadron War Bond Campaign is \$86,000. To date the men on this base have subscribed to \$28,190.00 or 32% of this total.

The M.P.s have outstripped the rest of the units on this base. They are 130% over their unit's quota.

The Ordnance men have exceeded their quota by 20%, and are still going strong in second place.

Here is the position of the remainder of the units as of last night:
