"Reports from WBS, CZ, LTOUSA, APO 515, indicate that officers continue to make purchases of Officer clothing from Sales Stores and mobile units for the benefit of enlisted men.

This practice is in direct violation of the regulations governing the allowances of clothing for officers, (Adm Cir 81, Hq, SOS, ETOUSA, 3 November 1943) and will be curtailed immediately."

4. WEARING OF INTERMEDIATE FLYING CLOTHING (A-9 AND B-10) BY GROUND CREMEN: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division dated 2 July 1944:

"BAFSC ADVISES GROUND CREMEN HAVE BEEN ISSUED AND ARE WEARING INTERMEDIATE FLYING CLOTHING (A-9 AND B-10). THIS PRACTICE MUST BE DISCONTINUED AS A-9 AND B-10 CLOTHING WILL BE NEEDED FOR USE WITH NE': TYPE F-3 ELEC HEATED CLOTHING WHICH WILL EVENTUALLY BE IN GENERAL USE. EFFORT IS BEING MADE TO HAVE B-3 JACKETS AUTHORIZED FOR ISSUE IN LIEU OF D-1 MECHANICS JACKETS.
