2. LIBERTY RUN FOR ENLISTED MEN: 32nd Sta Compl Sq will furnish one officer.
3. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division, dated 1 September 1944:  
"1 BD S-29-C EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, POSITION VACANCY STATUS AS SHOWN IN PERSONAL HISTORY STATEMENT AND PAR FOUR OF RECOMMENDATION FORM WILL BE COMPUTED BY USING AUTHORIZATION SET FORTH IN LTR, HQS, 1ST BOMB DIV, SUBJ: "REDUCTION IN COMBAT CREW STRENGTH", DATED 21 AUGUST 1944. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS REDUCTION, THE T/C SQUADRONS LIMITED TO TWENTY COMBAT CREWS ARE NOW AUTHORIZED NINETY T/C LEUTENANTS, THIRTY T/C FIRST LIEUTENANTS AND FOURTEEN CAPTAINS. THE REMAINING T/C SQUADRONS ALLOTTED FIFTEEN COMBAT CREWS ARE AUTHORIZED NINETY SEVEN LIEUTENANTS, THIRTY SEVEN FIRST LIEUTENANTS AND FIFTEEN CAPTAINS.

4. SOLDIER VOTING: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division dated 2 September 1944:

"1 BD S-49-G POL T/A RECEIVED FROM HQS, POLS. FOR YOUR INFO AND GUIDANCE:  
QUOTE: SA-45705 RESTRICTED 30/8/44: TEXAS STATE LAW REQUIRED PAYMENT OF POLL TAX PRIOR TO THIRTY ONE JANUARY FORTY FIVE PERIOD IF TAX NOT PAID PRIOR TO THAT DATE STATE ASSESSOR BALLOT WILL NOT BE FURNISHED PERIOD TEXAS WILL ACCEPT FEDERAL BALLOT WITHOUT PAYMENT OF POLL TAX SIGNED EISENHOWER.  
UNQUOTE. THIS INFO SHOULD BE POSTED ON ALL SOLDIER VOTING POSTERS KC T/C.

5. SOLDIER BALLOTS: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division dated 2 September 1944:

1 BD S-48-G POL T/A PH H) ETCONS. FOR YOUR INFO AND COMPLIANCE:  
QUOTE: SA-45708 RESTRICTED 30/8/44: REPORTS RECEIVED OF BALLOT ENVELOPE FLAPS BECOMING STUCK TO ENVELOPES REQUIRING FORCEFUL SEPARATION FOR USE IN VOTING PERIOD. IF EVENT FEDERAL OR STATE BALLOT IS RECEIVED NECESSITATING FORCEFUL SEPARATION VOTER WILL USE KEYS OF SEPARATION WHICH IS LEAST INJURIOUS TO FEDERAL OR STATE VOTER WILL, AFTER VOTING, SEAL AND CLOSE ENVELOPE PRACTICABLE AND WRITE ON BACK QUOTE ENVELOPE FLAP STUCK WILL REQUIRING FORCEFUL OPENING BEFORE VOTING UNQUOTE AND BE SIGNED BY VOTER AND INDIVIDUAL ADMINISTERING VOTERS OATH SIGNED EISENHOWER PERIOD IF NO CASE WILL A DAMAGED FEDERAL BALLOT OR ENVELOPE BE USED IF UNBROKEN ONE AVAILABLE PERIOD UNQUOTE
