YESTERDAY COORDINATED ATTACK BY THE EIGHTH AND FIFTEENTH AIR FORCES AGAIN SPREAD OUR AIRCRAFT OVER ALL OF GERMANY. IT IS WITH GREAT PLEASURE THAT I FORWARD TO YOU THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE JUST RECEIVED FROM GENERAL ARNOLD: "STRATEGIC OPERATION WHICH PUT NEARLY 3,000 AIRCRAFT INTO COORDINATED ATTACK AGAINST GERMANY IS SUBJECT OF MY HEARTIEST CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL CONCERNED". I WISH TO ADD MY OWN COMMENDATION ON THE EXCELLENT SHOWING. IT IS INDEED GRATIFYING TO FORWARD SUCH A MESSAGE. DDOOLITTLE" WILLIAMS COMBODIV ONE"
