QUOTE: RELEAF HQ ETO AG 210, 71 17 JULY 1944 SUB PASSES AND INFORMAL IN 24 HOUR DURATION. ALL RESTRICTIONS ON BEDS IN ARC CLUBS IN LONDON REMAIN TEMP SUSPENDED. HOWEVER, ORGS WISHING TO SEND MORE THAN 300 AT ONE TIME WILL FACILITATE HANDLING BY PHONING SP SERV OFF CBS ETOUSA 1555, 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE. DOOLITTLE UNQUOTE

6. ATTENTION FINANCE AND WAR BOND OFFICERS: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division, dated 3 August 1944:
"FOLLOWING TELETYPE RECEIVED 8TH AIR FORCE DATED 2 AUGUST 44 QUOTED FOR YOUR INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE: QUOTE REGULATIONS DO NOT PERMIT FIN OFF. EIGHTH AF TO CASH OR TAKE INTO THEIR ACCTS PERSONAL DOLLAR CHECKS, BUT PURCHASE OF WAR BONDS BY DOLLAR CHECKS MAY BE HANDLED BY WAR BOND OFF. WAR BOND OFF. WILL FORWARD CHECK MADE PAYABLE OR ENDORSED TO TREASURER OF US WITH COMPLETED FORM 44RC DIRECT TO TREASURER OF US. ADVISE ALL UNDER YOUR JURISDICTION.
