1. CAPTIVE OF THE DAY 1100 hrs 5 June 1944, to 1100 hrs 6 June 1944
2ND LT HOWARD J. SCHROEDER O-861771 407th Bomb Sq (H)
2. LIBERTY BOND FOR ENLISTED MEN: 446th Sub-Depot will furnish one officer.
3. COMMENDATION: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division dated 2 June 1944:

"FOLLOWING MSG FROM CG USSTAF RELAYED FOR YOUR INFO AND RELAY TO ALL CONCERNED QUOTE THE WEIGHT AND EFFECTIVENESS OF YOUR ATTACKS DURING THE PAST MONTH REPRESENT FULL EXPLOITATION OF THE POWER WITHIN YOUR FORCE. THESE ATTACKS HAVE NOT ONLY CONTINUED THE EXCELLENT OPERATIONS OF PREVIOUS MONTHS IN WEARING DOWN THE GERMAN AIR STRENGTH WHICH STAND GUARD OVER THEIR WAR MACHINE, BUT HAVE STRUCK HEAVILY AT ITS HEART. PARTICULARLY SUCCESSFUL HAVE BEEN THE ATTACKS ON THE ENEMY'S LIMITED OIL RESOURCES, BOTH AGAINST THE PLOESTI REFINERIES AND THE SYNTHETIC OIL PLANTS IN GERMANY. PLEASE EXTEND MY COMMENDATIONS TO THE AIR CREWS AND ALL OTHERS OF YOUR COMMAND RESPONSIBLE FOR THESE OPERATIONS. SGT SPAATZ. UNQUOTE DOOLITTLE. UNQUOTE WILLIAMS.
