2. LIBERTY RUN FOR ENLISTED MEN: 32nd Sta Compl Sq will furnish one officer.
3. ATTENTION ALL OFFICER PERSONNEL: Under new regulations and procedure, all officers having a Class "B" Allotment in effect, which was not started prior to 1 September 1944, must submit two (2) copies of form 29-6 (Authorization for Class "B" Allotment) to keep the allotment in effect. Officers, who have made allotments prior to 1 September 1944, should look through their personal 201 files for the copy of the 29-6 which they were given for their records at the time they inaugurated their allotments and give it to the enlisted man in their orderly room who regularly types their pay voucher each month, that he may make two copies of 29-6 from the information thereon. In other words, all officer allotments must be renewed this month.  
If 29-6's are not made up on allotments now in effect, the allotment will be automatically discontinued as of 31 August 44. However, it is not the desire of this command that this new change, which is to facilitate demobilization, will be an incentive to personnel to cancel their allotments by not submitting new 29-6's. Keep your allotments in effect. Have new 29-6's made up AT ONCE.
4. PERSONNEL RETURNING TO THE U.S.: All personnel returning to the U.S. who have baggage to be shipped, will address same to the RCD shown on their orders and not to any address in the U.S.
