3. ATTENTION ALL COMBAT PERSONNEL: It has been reported to this headquarters that combat crewmembers have been removing FLAK HELMETS from aircraft upon returning from missions. FLAK HELMETS and FLAK SUITS are placed in each aircraft by the Ordnance Section for your protection. Don't cheat the other fellow of such critical items by carrying them off to the barracks or locker rooms. FLAK HELMETS are distributed two per aircraft, for the top turret gunner and ball turret gunner. Discrepancies outlined above will be discontinued immediately.
4. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: Following teletype received from Hq 1st Bomb Div, dated 11 April 1944:
"DISCONTINUE ACCEPTANCE OF CCS APPLICATIONS FOR CWS AND CMP CCS. NO ADDITIONAL CANDIDATES WILL BE ENROLLED. SCHOOLS WILL BE CLOSED UPON COMPLETION OF PRESENTLY ENROLLED CLASSES".
