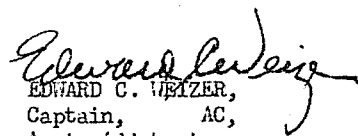
5. IDENTIFICATION TAGS: The following 1st Bomb Division Instruction 35-6,
