PAY RECORD. PAR 12 AR 345-155 WILL BE AMENDED ACCORDINGLY. THIS IS REPEAT
OF WAR DEPT MSG 10 MAY. ADVISE ALL CONCERNED UNDER YOUR JURISDICTION.
