Foreign language red-bordered V-Mail will be completely addressed and the language indicated in soft pencil on both sides. Enlisted men's red-bordered V-Mail will be censored and completely addressed on both sides, but will not be sealed.
- ATTENTION JEWISH PERSONNEL: Chaplain Klausner will conduct a Worship Service for the men of this area at Station 105, this evening, 18 May 1944. Transportation will leave Chaplain Ware's office at 18:30 hours.
