A minimum of 2/- has been established by 1st Division, but if we limit ourselves to this amount, we can never hope to raise anywhere near the £350 mark.

When you make your donation, after being paid next Wednesday, make it a big one. Give all you can. Any amount in excess of the £350 needed this month will be put in a reserve fund to be used for the figure needed next month. This fund is to be swelled on every payday by your contributions.

We all feel that nothing is too good for the Prisoners of War of this Group. We know they have no PX's in Germany. We know too, by reading the papers and listening to what crew members say who have been fortunate in escaping, the hardships our friends and buddies are going through. It isn't a DUTY for us to give to this fund --- it's a PRIVILEGE!

And at the same time, remember --- YOU could be a Prisoner of War!!! It MAY happen to you!!!
