3. FLYING CONTROL TRAINING: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division dated 3 May 1944:

"APPLICATIONS FOR FLYING CONTROL TRAINING WILL BE RECEIVED THIS HEADQUARTERS UNTIL 1700 HOURS 12 MAY 44 FROM ANY OFFICERS YOUR COMMAND INTERESTED IN BECOMING FLYING CONTROL OFFICERS AND WHOM YOU CONSIDER QUALIFIED FOR SUCH TRAINING. TRAINING WILL BEGIN 12 JUNE 44. COURSE COVERS TWO MONTHS. SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS WILL NOT REPEAT NOT BE RETURNED TO YOUR COMMAND. AIR CREW PERSONNEL TEMPORARILY GROUNDED WILL NOT APPLY."

4. OFFICERS' PROMOTIONS: Effectively immediately no inquiries will be made to this Headquarters concerning status of promotions. Inquiries to this Headquarters will be limited to those concerning officers returning to the Zone of Interior, or to other exceptional cases. All such inquiries will only be made by the Commanding Officer, Executive Officer, Adjutant, or 1st Sergeant. Inquiries contrary to the above will be disregarded.

5. LEAVE OF ABSENCE: All Officers of this Command will, prior to going on leave, complete the leave of absence form, in duplicate. Applications for leave of absence must be approved by the Commanding Officer of the applicant. The original copy of leave form will be carried by the individual until return from leave. Duplicate copy of leave form will be filed in the Orderly Room of the officer's organization. When more than forty-eight (48) hour leaves are granted, copies of Special Orders authorizing leave will also be carried by the officer concerned until return from such absence.
