2. LIBERTY RUN FOR UNLISTED MEN: 326th Bomb Sq (H) furnish one officer.

3. LIBERTY RUN: Effective immediately an officer will ride in the front seat of each truck on the Liberty Run.

Organizations will continue to detail an officer to be in charge of the Liberty Run. This officer will ride in the front seat of the lead truck.

The Officer of the Day will be at the assembly point in front of Site 2 each night at 1825 hours to detail officers to ride in the front seat of each truck. These officers will be detailed from officers riding in the back of the officers' trucks.

The officer in charge of the Liberty Run will be certain an officer is in the front seat of each vehicle when it departs from N.....

4. PREPARATION OF MORNING REPORTS: Paragraph 3b of Memorandum 35-5, Headquarters, VIII Air Force dated 21 March 1944 will be strictly complied with by all units submitting Morning Reports to this Headquarters.

5. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: Attention is directed to ETOUSA Circular #33 dated 21 March 1944 for strict compliance. All commanders will take necessary action to insure that all personnel in their command fully understand all provisions.

6. RATION CARDS: The Post Exchange cannot issue new Ration Cards to replace those reported as being lost or misplaced. Rations are ordered on basis of strength which makes this ruling necessary. One Ration Card per man.
