

1. OFFICER OF THE DAY 1100 6 May 1944 to 1100 hrs 7 May 1944
1ST LT VERNON E. KOCH O-2044610 326th Bomb Sq (H)
2. LIBERTY RUN FOR ENLISTED MEN: 32nd Sta Compl Sq furnish one Officer.
3. DOGS: All enlisted men are warned that dogs are NOT allowed in Mess Halls. All dogs caught in Mess Halls will be turned over to A.S.P.C.A. at K.....
4. V-MAIL: Black V-mail will be issued and used until the supply is exhausted. It will be separated as before. Red V-Mail will be separated from, and used simultaneously with, the Black V-Mail, but censored, and addressed on both sides while left open. It will be separated and clearly marked as follows:
 - a. REQUIRING BASE CENSORSHIP - Separation marked - Uncensored.
 - b. ADDRESSED TO U.S. ADDRESSES - Separation marked - United States.
 - c. MISCELLANEOUS - Separation marked - Miscellaneous.All V-Mail will be deposited in the Base Post Office before 1000 hours.
5. WASTE PAPER AND TRASH: Effective immediately all waste paper and trash will be placed in separate receptacles by all organizations. Receptacles containing both paper and trash mixed together will NOT be collected for disposal by Station Utilities. It will then be the responsibility of the Site Commander to dispose of such trash containing paper.
