2. LIBERTY RUL FOR ENLISTED MEN: 325th Bomb Sq, furnish one Officer.
3. DOGS: Effective immediately, the following will govern the ownership of dogs:
 - a. Dogs will be licensed and will be registered with the local Military Police Sq.
 - b. Dogs will not be permitted in barracks.
 - c. Dogs will not be permitted to run loose on the Station. All dogs caught running loose will be picked up by the Military Police and disposed of.
 - d. No dogs will be permitted in or around any mess hall on this Station. All dogs caught in the vicinity of any mess hall will be disposed of immediately by the Military Police.The contents of this directive will be brought to the attention of all members of this command.
4. ATTENTION ALL CONCERNED: The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Div:
"IT IS DECIDED BY HIGHER HEADQUARTERS THAT PERSONNEL QUALIFIED AS ELECTRICIAN, BRICKLAYERS, CARPENTERS OR PLUMBERS WHO ARE ON LEAVE OR PASS UP LONDON BE ENCOURAGED TO VOLUNTEER SERVICES AT THE STAGE DOOR CANTEN. THIS PERSONNEL SHOULD REPORT TO CAPT WHITE, 201 PICCADILLY".
