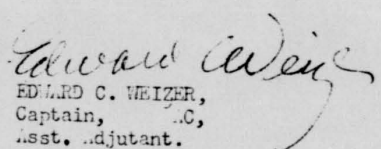

PLS CONVEY IT TO MEMBERS OF YOUR COMMAND TOGETHER WITH MY CONGRATULATIONS. IT INDICATES THE HIGH STANDARD OF COMBAT EFFICIENCY WITHIN YOUR RESPECTIVE UNITS. DOOLITTLE'. MY CONGRATULATIONS TO BOTH AIR AND GROUND PERSONNEL. KEEP IT UP."
