1. In accordance with the provisions of Par 21, AR 600-550, C4, and AR 420-5, MAJOR WILLIAM D. SMITH, O-278570, is hereby appointed to investigate the circumstances and report the facts leading up to and connected with the death of Sgt. RICHARD (NMI) DZIEDZIECH 10600639, 407th Bomb Sq (H), which occurred 30 Jan 1944 in the vicinity of this sta, and to determine as a result of such investigation whether death occurred in line of duty and whether it was or was not the result of the deceased's own misconduct.

The proceedings and findings will be governed by the above quoted regulations and report submitted to this Headquarters in sextuplicate on WDAGO Form 51 (Report of Investigation) as soon as practicable.

2. UP AR 600-550, and in accordance with Par 13c, STCUSA Cir No. 18, 22 Aug 1942, W/Sgt. WILLIAM H. BRYAN 14033811, 407th Bomb Sq (H), WPM fr this sta to Brookwood Cemetery as escort to accompany the remains of Sgt. RICHARD (NMI) DZIEDZIECH 10600639, 407th Bomb Sq (H), and upon completion of duty as escort will return to his proper orgn and sta. CMT TDN FSA 91-5 P 432-02 A 212/40425.

It being impractical for the Govt to furn subs or billets, the PD will pay the mon alws in lieu of rat and qrs as prescribed by Table II, Par c, WD Bulletin 41 for one (1) man for the number of days spent while traveling and while at temp dy sta where rat and qrs are not available and are not furn, the appropriate mon alws to be calculated by the PD to whom you is submitted for payment.

3. So much of Par 1, SO #29 this Hq cs, pertaining to TD of MAJOR LEO I. EISENMAN, O-464411 JMC, as reads: "1 Day" is amended to read "4 Days".
