StiMhST: Report on Planning and Execution of Operations of Dission #195 of the 92nd Romberdment Group, 17 September 1944, Holland.

- TO : Commanding Officer, 92nd Bombardment Group (H) Auf, ABO #557.
  - 1. Comment on Planning and Axecution.

a. In bomb loading for this operation was received from Head marters with Combat Wing by # capt. Hamilton at 0200 hours, 17 September 1944. The order called for thirty (30) B-17's to be loaded with 30 x 260 pound fragmentation bombs, each with inst. nose fuse and no tail fuse.

b. The Field Order was received from Headquarters 1st Bomb Division by Capt. Hamilton at 6240 hours, 17 September 1944. Flight plans and details of the mission were completed and briefing being set for 6360 hours and take Off time 6660 hours.

2. Jeneral Larrative.

a. Thirty (30) sircraft of the And Bomb Group began take off at 0600 hours for assembly on the Honeybourne Buncher at 8,000, and 7,000 feet. These aircraft formed the lead, Low Groups of the 40th "C" Combat Wing.

b. The Lead Group was composed of three (3) squadrons and the low Group of two (1) squadrons. Each of these squadrons consisted of six (6)  $\mathbb{A}/\mathbb{C}$ .

- c. The lead group departed the assembly buncher at 0708 hours, the Low Group renezvoused in position along the first assembly leg. The prescribed route over England was followed to Chelmsford where a thirty (30) minute delay was relayed from the 40th "A" Combat Wing. The 40th "C" Combat Wing made two (2) 300 degree turns coming out ahead of the 40th "B" Combat Wing. The 40th "C" Combat Wing fell in behind the 40th "B" and crossed the English Coast over Clacton at 0825 hours. After departing the English Coast the 40th "C" Combat Wing flew the briefed route to the I.P.
- d. At the I.F. the five, six ship squadrons took interval and made individual run on assigned targets. The Lead and Low squadroms bombed the rrimary from 18,000 feet at 0942 hours on a 034 degree magnetic heading. The High Squadron, Lead Group bombed the Frimary from 18,500 feet on a 038 degree magnetic heading at 0943 hours. The Lead Squadron, Low Group bombed the Frimary from 17,000 feet on a 034 degree magnetic heading at 0944 hours. The Low S undron, Low Group bombed the Frimary from 16,500 feet on a 015 degree magnetic heading at 0947 hours. After bombing all Squadrons except the High S undron Lead Group followed briefed route out and rendezvoused south of brussels. The High S undron turned left after bombing to avoid other formations on bomb run, and teturned to the briefed route. All formations crossed the English Coast at approximately the same time along briefed route and returned to base.
