SUBJECT: Report on Planning and Execution of Operations of Mission 27 May 1944.

TO Commanding Officer, 92nd Bombardment Group (H) AAF, APO #557.

1. Comment on Planning and Execution.

The bomb loading for this operation was received from Headquarters, 40th Combat Wing by Capt. Prasse at 0930 hours, 27 Lay 1944. The order called for six (6) B-17's to be loaded with 12 X 500 GP bombs each with 1/10th sec. nose fuse and 1/40 sec. tail fuse.

The Field Order was received from Headquarters, 1st Bomb Division by Capt. Prasse at Oll9 hours, 27 May 1944. Flight plans and details of the mission were completed, briefing being set for 0815 hours and take-off time 1110 hours.

2. Take-off was accomplished by six (6) B-17's from the 92nd Group, beginning at 1110 hours. These aircraft assembled over the base as High Squadron with the 306th Group.

Any further unformation regarding this mission, refer to the general narrative of the 306th Group.

- 3. Aircraft Not Attacking. All of the six (6) B-17's from the 92nd Group that took off attacked the primary target.
