SUBJECT: Report on Planning and Execution of Operations, 172nd Mission, Anklam, Germany, 4 August 1944.

: Jonganding Officer, 92nd Bombardment Group, APO 557.

1. Corment on Planning and Execution.

a. The book leading for this operation was received from Headquarters 40th Combat Wing by Capt. Sayrl at 2154 hours & August 1944. The order called for eleven (11) 3-17's and two (2) FFF eircraft to be loaded with 10 X 500 lb. OF bombs each with 1/10 sec. nose fuse and 1/100 aec, tail fuse plus twenty-six (26) B-17's to be 1 aded with 10 X M-17 IB's.

b. The Field Order was received from Headquarters lst Bomb Division by Jart, Smyrl at 2154 hours, 3 August 1944. Flight plens and details of the mission were completed, briefing being set for 0530 hours and toke-off time 0900 hours.

2. Ceneral Narrative.

B-17's, two (2) PFT, and three (3) spares, began taking off at 0901 hours and assembled on the Mount Farm Buncher at 4000, 5000, and 6000 feet, flying as Low, Lead and High Groups of the 40th "B" Combat Wing. The buncher was departed at 1001 hours and the briefed route followed over England. The English coset was departed at 1115g hours

after the wing assembled with the Division.

b. The route to the IP was as planned and without incident. The IP was reached at 1450 hours. A helpful and accurate weather rejort of the target area was received by the Wing Command from the scouting arearaft. This report enabled the Wing Commander to order

the Low and High Groups to take visual bombing intervals at the IP.

2. The Lead Group visually bombed the primary target at 1504 hours from 18,500 feet while on a magnetic heading 66 213 degrees. The Low Group visually bombed the Primar; terget at 1506 hours from 18,100 feet, magnetic heading 212 degrees. The lead aircraft of the High Group could not drop on the primery target because of bomb bay door failure, but the Group Leader notified all sircraft concerned, and the Group dropped on the lead gircraft flare and VHT signal. Bombs were away at 1507 hours from 20000 feet while on a magnetic heading of 234 degrees.

1. The three groups of the 40th "5" Combot Wing rellied after the target and followed the briefed route home. The English doast was prosed at 1747 home. Base was reached at 1725 hours.

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- 3. Aircraft Not Attacking.
 All aircraft except one, #49-97400 from the Lead Group, attacked the primary target. #49-97400 aborted because the pilot-failed to find the formation. The epope following. Two spares returned as unused.
