SUBJECT: Report on Planning and Execution of Operations of Mission & March 1944, Berlin,

- 10 t Commanding Officer, 92nd Bombardment Group (H) AAF, APO 634.
 - 1. Comment on Planning and Execution.
- e. The bomb loading for this operation was received from Head-quarters 40th Combat wing by Capt. Frasse at 2000 hours 7 Larch 1944. The order called for thenty-one (21) B-17's to be loaded with 36 x 100 GP bombs each with 1/10 second nose fuse and 1/40 second tail fuse, and four (4) B-17's to be loaded with Leximum 1-47.4 Incendiary Lombs.
- b. The Field Order was received from Headquarters 1st Bomb Division by Capt. Frasse at 2240 hours 7 March 1944. Flight plans and details of the mission were completed, briefing set for 0600 hours and take-off time 0900 hours.
 - 2. General Marrative.
 - a. Main formation (Low Group 40th Combet Wing)

(1) Take-off was accomplished by twenty-one (21) B-17's from the 92nd Bomb Group beginning at 0900 hours. The assembly for these aircraft was made over Fodington on the 40th Combat wing Buncher at 1004 hours flying as low group of the 40th Combat wing.

- (2) The route out was followed according to flight plan and the inglish coast was departed at 1104 hours. The enemy coast was entered at 1156 hours at an altitude of 20, 500 feet. The I.P. was reached at 1435 hours and the 92nd Bomb Broup bembed the primary target at 1440 hours on a magnetic heading of 230 degrees at 25,000 feet as shown in Diagram *C*. The 92nd Bomb Broup rallied with the 40th Compat wing after the target and began a descent. The inglish coast was crossed at 1652 hours and a procedure let down was made over Bolasher # 5 from 9,000 feet. The base was reached by the lead aircraft at 1752 hours.
- b. 92nd 305th Composite High Lquadron (High Composite Sp. 40th E) (1) Take-cif on a complicated by four (4) D-17ts from the 92nd Bomb Group Deginning at 0915 hours. These aircraft assembled as shown in Diagram *B* over the 40th Combat wing Buncher where they joined three (3) direcraft from the 305th Lomb Group which formed the high Equadron. The formation departed 40th Combat wing Buncher at 1801 hours for immediate rendezvous achign Composite Group with the 40th Combat Wing.
