EN HQ 84F: "IT IS INDEED A PLEASURE TO FORWARD THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE, DATED 26 NOV, FROM THE AOC RAF Q GROUP: "PLEASE ACCEPT MY HEARTIEST CONGRATULATIONS ON THE OUTSTANDING AND TRULY MAGNIFICENT ACHIEVEMENTS OF BOTH YOUR BOMBER AND FIGHTER AIRCREW AND PILOTS IN DESTROYING NO LESS THAN 236 GERMAN ACFT DURING THE LAST 2 DAYS NOT TO MENTION THE DEMOLISHING EFFECTS OF YOUR BOMBING. GRATEFUL IF YOU WOULD CONVEY PARTICULARLY TO YOUR FIGHTER PILOTS THE warmest animation congratulations and good wishes of mine on the tremendous war winning successes they have and are achieving in shooting down the enemy. SOD COLE-HAMILTON"

FROM HQ 84F: "PLEASE EXTEND MY PERSONAL CONGRATULATION AS WELL AS THAT OF THE ENTIRE EIGHTH AIR FORCE TO ALL FIGHTER UNITS OF YOUR COMMANDS FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING DISPLAY OF AGGRESSIVE AERIAL TACTICS AGAINST THE ENEMY FIGHTER FORCE ON MISSIONS OF 26 AND 27 NOV 1944. THE RECORD DESTRUCTION OF OVER 200 ENEMY A/C HAS ONCE AGAIN SHOWN THE SUPERIORITY OF OUR FIGHTERS AGAINST THE ENEMY. EACH INDIVIDUAL PILOT IS TO BE CONGRATULATED FOR THE PART HE PLAYED ON THE FIGHTER TEAM THAT SEEMS TO DESTROY THE GERMAN AIR FORCE. LIKEWISE EXTEND MY CONGRATULATIONS TO THE BOMBER CREWS FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF SIXTEEN ENEMY A/C. SOD DOOLITTLE".
