BY ORDER OF THE COMMANDING GENERAL HQ COM Z ETO EFFECTIVE FOR THE RATION PERIOD COMMENCING 24 DECEMBER CMA UNIFORM RATION ALLOWANCE FOR CIGARETTES FOR ALL PERSONNEL OF THE EUROPEAN THEATRE OF OPERATIONS FIXED AT FIVE PACKAGES PER WEEK PD REQUEST DISTRIBUTION OF ABOVE INFORMATION TO UNITS YOUR COMMAND UNQUOTE  
TURNER COMBODIV ONE"
5. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: The following teletype received from Commanding General, HQ, United Kingdom Base, is quoted for your information and compliance:  
"ON TWO THREE CMA TWO FOUR CMA TWO FIVE CMA TWO SIX CMA THREE ZERO AND THREE ONE DECEMBER AND ONE JANUARY JOURNEYS BY RAIL BEYOND TWO ZERO MILES FOR PERSONNEL ON LEAVE CMA FURLOUGH AND PASS IS PROHIBITED PD  
THE ONLY EXCEPTION WILL BE IN CASES OF EMERGENCY PD IN SUCH CASES PASSES WILL BE ENDORSED IN RED INK ON THE FACE OF THE PASS BY THE CO OF THE UNIT WITH THE WORDS QUOTE AUTHORIZED TO TRAVEL BY RAIL UNQUOTE PD THOSE ALREADY ON LEAVE WILL BE AUTHORIZED TO RETURN TO THEIR PROPER STATIONS BY TRAIN ON THE DATES SPECIFIED ABOVE PD RTOS RPT RTOS WILL ENDORSE PASSES TO GIVE EFFECT TO THIS WHERE NECESSARY PD  
VAUGHN  
No furloughs, passes or leaves will be approved for any point beyond the twenty mile radius. All furloughs, passes and leaves which have already been approved and go into effect during the restricted period for points outside the twenty mile radius will be altered to conform with the above quoted teletype.  
The following are the extreme points in the twenty mile radius to which furloughs, passes and leaves may be approved for members of this command:  
TO THE NORTH OF THIS STATION - - Corby - Market Harbour  
TO THE WEST OF THIS STATION - - Daventry  
TO THE EAST OF THIS STATION - - Huntingdon  
TO THE SOUTH OF THIS STATION - - Leighton Buzzard  
The following, as defined by this headquarters, are considered emergencies for which furloughs, passes and leaves may be granted:
