4. FLIGHT OFFICERS AND GUNNERY APPLICATIONS FOR DIRECT APPOINTMENT AS 2ND LT:
The following teletype received from 1st Bomb Division, dated 21 December 1944:

FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF SENIOR FLIGHT SURGEON ON WD AGO FORM 64.

4. OFFICERS' PAY VOUCHERS: All officers will sign their pay vouchers at the
organization Orderly Room before they are submitted to the Finance Office for
computation. They will not sign them at the Finance Office before pay day,
unless a change has occurred in their status after vouchers have been submitted.
5. WAR BOND REPORTS: All organizations will submit a report of War Bonds
purchased by officers and enlisted men either by cash or under Class "B"
Allotments for December 1944 to the FINANCE OFFICE by 20 December 1944. This
report is the same as was previously submitted to Special Service Office.
6. MONEY CABLES: Authority to send money home by cable through Barclay's Bank
which was discontinued last month has now been reinstated. A representative of
Barclay's Bank, Thrapston, will be at this Station on January 2nd 1945 for the
purpose of accepting money cables as well as air-mailing flowers and candies for
anniversary gifts, etc.
7. ATTENTION ALL UNIT COMMANDERS: All organizations will submit a report to
Station S-1 stating the number and amount of Class "B" (War Bond) allotments
for the month of December, of officers in their command, not later than 0900
hours 29 December 1944.
