Specification: In that Private First Class ***** did, at AAF Station 109, APO 557, on or about 1 September 1944, wrongfully take and use, without proper authority, a certain motor vehicle, to wit: a 3/4 ton 4x4 Dodge ambulance, property of the United States, of a value of more than \$50.00.

FINDINGS

Of Specification of Charge: "Guilty"

SENTENCE

To be reduced to the grade of Private; to be confined at hard labor at such place as the reviewing authority may direct for a period of 3 months, and to forfeit \$20.00 of his pay per month for a like period. (Record of NO previous Convictions Considered).

CHARGE: Violation of the 96th Article of War.

Specification: In that Private ***** did, at AAF Station 109, on or about 20 September 1944, wrongfully take and use, without proper authority, a certain motor vehicle, to wit: a 3/4 ton 4x4 Ford Reconnaissance car, property of the United States, of a value of more than \$50.00.

FINDINGS

Of Specification of Charge: "Guilty"

SENTENCE

To be confined at hard labor at such place as the reviewing authority may direct for 4 months, and to forfeit \$20.00 of his pay per month for a like period. (Record of ONE Previous Conviction Considered).
